

Two Reasons We Shouldn't Fear Being Devoured By the Devil

- Satan has been defeated by Jesus. (12:7-12)
 - When was Satan thrown out of heaven?
 - Satan was defeated and thrown out of heaven when Jesus died, was resurrected, and ascended to heaven. (12:10)
 - What's the significance of Satan being thrown out of heaven?
 - Since Satan, our accuser, was thrown out of heaven he can no longer bring accusations against us before God. (12:10)
 - We won! (12:11)
- Satan can't defeat and devour the church (12:13-17)
 - Now that Satan's barred from heaven he seeks to devour God's people on the earth. (12:13, 15, 17)
 - As Satan seeks to devour God's people on earth, God protects them from being devoured. (12:14, 16)
