Four Exhortations Jesus Gives To Those Who Seem To Be Alive, But Are Really Spiritually Dead

•	Remember that you may be able to fool others, but you can't fool Jesus. He's the ultimate
	evaluator and judge of your true spiritual condition. (3:1, 4)

- You can have the reputation of being spiritually alive but in reality be spiritually dead.
- One of the main metrics Jesus uses to determine whether or not someone is spiritually alive is their works.
- Wake up! (3:2-3)
 - Establish your works.
 - Remember the gospel.
 - Keep the gospel.
 - Repent.
- Beware of the judgment that awaits those who don't wake up and repent. (3:3)
- Let the promises of what awaits those who conquer compel you to wake up and repent. (3:5-6)
 - You will be clothed in white garments.
 - Jesus will never blot your name out of the book of life.
 - Jesus will confess your name before his father and his angels.
