Psalm 51:1-19 John Crawford October 15, 2023

How to Respond When You Sin

- Confess your sin to the Lord. (51:3-6)
 - Confession of sin involves acknowledging and taking responsibility for your sin. (51:3)
 - Confession of sin involves acknowledging that your sin is first and foremost against God before it's against others. (51:4)
 - Confession of sin involves acknowledging that you are deserving of God's just judgment because of your sin. (51:4)
 - Confession of sin involves acknowledging that you haven't just sinned, but that you're a sinner. (51:5)
- Cry out to the Lord for forgiveness. (51:1-2, 7-9)
 - God's forgiveness is undeserving. (51:1)
 - God's forgiveness washes away our sin. (51:1-2, 7-9)
 - God's forgiveness hides his face from our sin. (51:9)
- Plead for the Lord to change and transform you. (51:10-12)
 - Ask the Lord for a renewed heart. (51:10)
 - Ask the Lord for ongoing ministry and service. (51:11)
 - Ask the Lord for restored joy. (51:12)

How to Respond to God's Forgiveness of Our Sin...

- You should evangelize! (51:13)
- You should sing! (51:14-15)
- You should walk in humility. (51:16-17)
