The Garden Created

- The Garden of Eden had...
 - The tree of life (Genesis 2:8-9)
 - A river (Genesis 2:10)
 - Adam and Eve serving as priests (Genesis 2:15)
 - Adam and Even reigning as kings (Genesis 1:26-28)
 - God's presence dwelling with his people. (Genesis 3:8)

The Garden Lost

- God banished Adam and Eve, and the rest of humanity after them, from the garden because of their sin. (Genesis 3:22-24)
- God pronounced a curse of judgment on everyone and everything outside the garden. (Genesis 3:14-19)

The Garden Foreshadowed/Promised

- Foreshadowed in the Old Testament tabernacle/temple (1 Kings 6, 7)
- Promised in Old Testament prophecies (Ezekiel 47:1-12; Zechariah 14:1-8)

The Garden Regained

- There will be a river of life. (22:1-2)
- There will be a tree of life. (22:2)
- There will no longer be a curse. (22:3)
- God will reign on his throne on the earth. (22:3)
- We will see God's face and glory. (22:4-5)
- We will serve as priests. (22:3-4)
- We will reign as kings. (22:5)
