

Revelation 4:1-11 John Crawford June 16, 2024

The Heavenly Throne Room

- The one seated on the throne...
 - He is the sovereign king and ruler of the universe. (v. 2)
 - He is inexpressibly glorious. (v. 3)
- Around the throne...
 - The rainbow signifies God's covenant faithfulness to creation. (v. 3)
 - The twenty four elders represent the church for all time. (v. 4)
- From the throne...
 - Lightning and thunder accompany God's awesome presence and fearful judgment. (v. 5).
- Before the throne...
 - The seven torches and spirits of God represent the Holy Spirit. (v. 5)
 - The sea of glass represents the expanse between the one on the throne from everything else in creation. (v. 6)
- On each side of the throne...
 - The four living creatures are angelic beings (vv. 6-8)
 - The four living creatures represent all of God's creation. (v. 7)
 - The four living creatures never stop praising the one seated on the throne. (vv. 8-11)
 - They never stop praising him for his infinite holiness. (v. 8)
 - They never stop praising him for his absolute sovereignty. (v. 8)
 - They never stop praising him for his sovereign rule over all of history. (v. 8)
 - The twenty four elders never stop praising the one seated on the throne. (v. 9-11)
 - They never stop praising him for his eternal existence. (v. 9-10)
 - They never stop praising him for bringing everything into existence. (v. 11)

The Implication of This Vision for Our Lives

- This vision enables us to endure suffering and tribulation in our lives.
- This vision compels us to worship the only one who is worthy of our worship.
- This vision empowers us to resist the sinful pleasures and temptation of this world.
- This vision motivates us to sing praises to the one who is seated on the throne.
